If you want to take your child swimming, please meet Miss Boyd in the swimming pool between 9am and 9.10am. Parents are responsible for their own child whilst in the changing rooms and pool and until they return to Enniskillen Nursery School. School will not be providing any transport.

Any child who does not want to go swimming can come to school as normal -staff will be in school.

## AUTUMN WALK
